

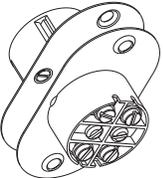

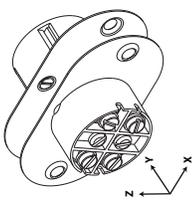
Operating and Installation Instructions



Description

This flush mounted magnetic door contact can be used in grade 1 security systems as specified in EN50131-1:2006 and is compliant to EN50131-2:62008 and environmental class II (for use indoors). It operates as a normally open circuit going closed in the presence of the magnet. A second reed is present for added versatility and security. This contact can be used on most doors to detect the unauthorised entry of an intruder.

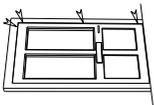

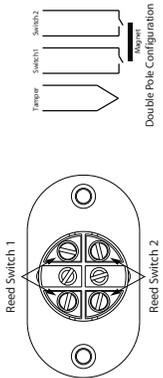

Mounting Instructions

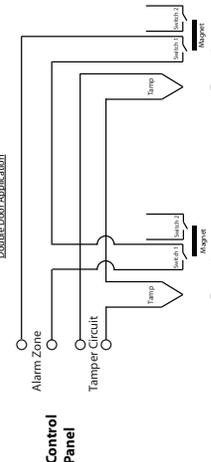
To install the contact housing, drill a 26mm hole into the door frame to a minimum depth of 15mm on the opening side of the door. If the face plate is required to be flush, mark around the plate and chisel out the wood to the required depth to allow the face plate to be flush with the door. This should be done on every opening side of the door.
Terminate the wires to requirements. Insert the unit into the required hole and secure with the screws provided. To fit the magnet, carefully mark the position on the door from the already fitted contact to ensure that the centre of the magnet is aligned with the centre of the contact. Drill a 26mm hole to a minimum depth of 17mm into the door, again chisel out the wood if flush fitting with the surface is required. Place the magnet casing into the hole and secure it using the screws provided. Please note that the plates on both parts must be lined up.

Wiring Configurations



To install this contact, connect the alarm zone from the control panel to two of the four silver coloured screws, these connect to the switch. Additionally the second two silver coloured screws can be wired as backup or may be wired to operate another circuit such as CCTV etc. The two tamper circuit wires from the control panel should be joined together using one of the two remaining yellow colour screws.

Double Door Application



To install these door contacts in a double door situation, wire the alarm and tamper circuits in series.
